REPORT OF THE CHAIRMAN

In accordance with the By-Laws of this General Committee of Adjustment and Section 11 (b) General Committee Rules of the By-Laws of the Brotherhood of Locomotive Engineers and Trainmen, I submit the following on the activities of this office for the period ending June 30, 2005.


