REPORT OF THE CHAIRMAN

ALL MEMBERS, GCoFA AND SECRETARY –
TREASURERS, BLE – UP NORTHERN REGION

Dear Sirs and Brothers:

Pursuant to Section 11 (b) of the Standing Rules and the By-Laws of this General Committee of Adjustment, I submit the following report on the activities of this office for the period ending June 30, 2010.

In addition to conducting the daily business of this office which includes telephone work, mail, email, discipline appeals, submission work, claims and grievances and correspondence, the following was further attended to by this office.

April 13, - 16, 2010, I traveled to Kansas City, Missouri for On-Property Section 6 Meetings with BLET/UPRR General Chairmen and Vice President Lee Pruitt.

April 18-22, 2010 I traveled to and attended the Western General Chairman's Association meeting held in Las Vegas, Nevada. Also in attendance were First Vice Chairman M. L. Elsberry and 2nd Vice Chairman K. T. Christians. While in Las Vegas, Vice Chairman Elsberry and I with Vice President Pruitt met with General Chairman Rightnowar and Union Pacific Labor Relations Officers T. M. Stone, General Director and T. G. Taggart, Director of Labor Relations on the establishment of the new Global 4 Yard also known as the Joliet Intermodal Terminal as an away from home terminal for the Fort Madison, Iowa crews and the establishment of and equity of hauler jobs at the JIT. The establishment of the hauler jobs has been completed by agreement of the parties. The establishment of the JIT as an away from home terminal is still under discussion.

May 22 – 27, 2010 I traveled to and attended Section 6 On-Property Meetings with BLET UPRR General Chairmen and Vice President Lee Pruitt and Gil Gore with Union Pacific Vice

President Labor Relations R. Turner; Assistant Vice President T. Olin; General Directors T. M. Stone and R. Guidry and General Director CMS M. Brazytis.

June 8, 2010, Claims Conference with Director Labor Relations T. G. Taggart. Also First Vice Chairman Elsberry met with Manager of Labor Relations J. Boyle for claims and discipline case conference.

June 15, 2010, Vice Chairman Elsberry and I attended a meeting (joint meeting) of Division 333, St. Paul, Minnesota at the invitation of Division 333 President, R. Behne. In attendance were Local Chairman D. Johnstone, Division 333; Ken Filarski, Chaplain 333; and Paul Schultz, 333. Also attending Jason Haller, Division 241 Local Chairman; Chris Bunton, President Division 369; Tony Dimond from Division 176 and Wisconsin State Legislative Board Chairman.

On June 16, 2010 while traveling I stopped at Clear Lake, Iowa for brief meeting with Local Chairmen Greg Welp, Division 656, Mason City and Eagle Grove.

We have also completed the Trip Rates for the Rochelle, Illinois to Fort Madison, Iowa Pool which goes into effect July 16, 2010.

We have also completed an agreement for the South Morrill, Nebraska Pool (Division 303) for first out Board Placement at the away from home terminal of Bill, Wyoming when Deadheading from South Morrill to Bill.

We have also completed an agreement for a 3 hour placement after notification of displacement to mark up to the Guaranteed Extra Board or the Guaranteed Pools at Bill, Wyoming (Division 31) or South Morrill (Division 303) without deduction of guarantee.

Local Agreements completed with Division 96 and Division 405 Weekend Work Agreement for Commuter Service.

Also Local Agreement between Division 96 and Commuter Operations for filling of vacation vacancies in Commuter Service.

Agreement with Union Pacific Labor Relations for Discipline Case 10-04 on behalf of Engineer R. Schwartz Division 369. Union Pacific agrees to withdraw and allow the claim with pay for time lost when Brother Schwartz was discipline for failure to secure unattended locomotive.

We have not received any Awards from the First Division; NRAB from the nearly 70 cases presented dot eh Board last December.
