IRS Standard Auto Mileage Rate Increases July 1

The Internal Revenue Service (IRS) recently announced the standard automobile mileage rate will increase to reflect changing fuel prices.

The IRS standard mileage rate, effective July 1, goes up to 58.5 cents per mile. The increase is 8 cents per mile.
